

I can't directly access or check your personal voter registration status, as that requires private information (like your full name, date of birth, address, and sometimes last four digits of your SSN) that I don't have and can't retrieve.

- For St. Louis County (if you're in the county rather than city), it also points to the Secretary of State's site.

It's a good idea to check before elections, as registrations can sometimes become inactive if you move or don't vote for a while. The deadline to register in Missouri is typically the fourth Wednesday before an election.
